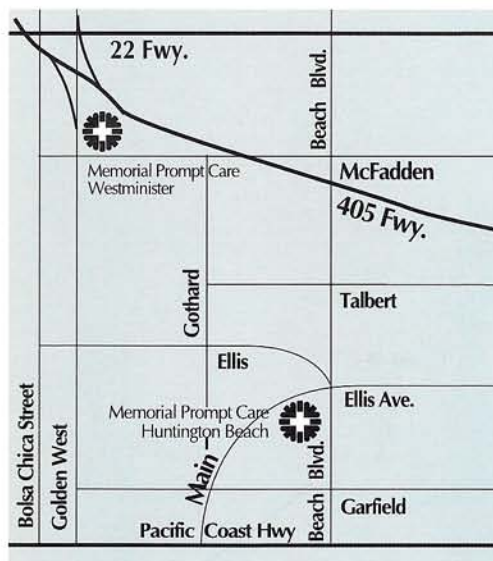

WHAT IS MICRODERMABRASION?

Micro (small),
Derma (skin),
Abrasion (abrade or remove)

To buff away a small amount of the external layer of skin - that is precisely what Microdermabrasion does. The process of cell renewal (exfoliation) is a natural process that slows with age and environmental exposure. As Microdermabrasion primarily removes the dead, dry cells, it also results in stimulating production of new skin cells, collagen and elastin that all combine to give skin its youthful elasticity and smooth, glowing appearance. Microdermabrasion is effective for all skin types and is especially effective for those areas which the aging process has often been accelerated by sun damage such as the face, neck, chest and hands.

HISTORY OF MICRODERMABRASION

Microdermabrasion was developed by a European dermatologist many decades ago and has been the most popular and historically the most performed facial rejuvenation treatment in the world. The current state-of-the-art refined version of Microdermabrasion uses very pure aluminum oxide crystals. These crystals are effortlessly directed with a tiny air-jet and a wand that glides over the skin as the used crystals and dead skin are simultaneously whisked away by a vacuum.

TREATMENT RESULTS

Microdermabrasion leaves your skin more smooth and clean with a mild flushing. Blackheads are loosened, whiteheads become unsurfaced, hyperpigmentation lightens, acne scars, enlarged pores and epidermal wrinkles become less prominent. Blood containing oxygen and nutrients is drawn to the surface to feed and repair cells, with increased thickness of the epidermis and new collagen deposition.

The process of Microdermabrasion should be approached in a series of an initial five treatments, two weeks apart and then monthly in order to maintain a lasting effect. Most patients actually feel and see a difference after one or two treatments, but additional sessions progressively enhance the results. To maintain lasting improvement, a proper skin care program should include moisturizers, sun block protection, exfoliants, and prescription skin bleaching products when needed.
